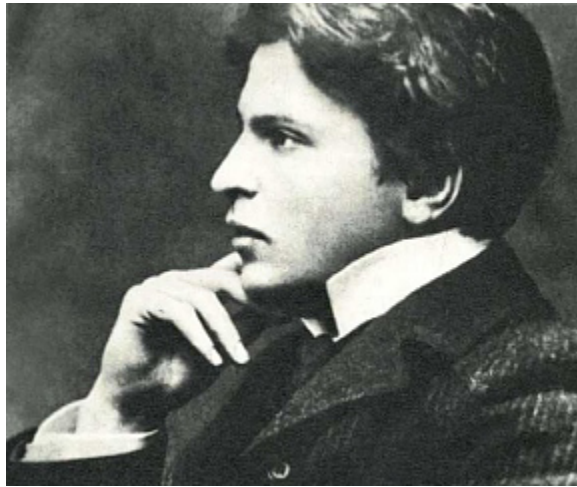


Music of GEORGE ENESCU in the catalog of Philharmusica / New York

GEORGE ENESCU (1881 – 1955), known in France as *Georges Enesco*, is considered to be the greatest Romanian musician. He was a composer, violinist, pianist, conductor, and teacher.
